To be eligible for home care, you must:

- Have a medical condition that requires the skill of a licensed professional on an intermittent, part-time basis
- Be under the continuous care of a physician who is willing to work with a home health services provider
- Be homebound as required by Medicare and some insurance policies

Health services include:

- Nursing services
 - Medical surgical care
 - Oncology care

- Physical, Occupational and Speech Therapy
- Home Health Aides
- Medical social worker services
- Nutrition counseling

A Registered Nurse (RN) is available to take your call 7 days a week.



SKILLED NURSING SERVICES

Experienced Registered Nurses (RN) and Licensed Vocational Nurses (LVN) perform a variety of services prescribed by the attending physician. Adventist Home Health Nursing Staff assists the physician in determining the patient's treatment needs, performs the care and maintains contact with the physician in order to report the patient's health status.

Our Nurses do wound care, instruction and administration of medications, catheter care, pain management and diabetic management services

HOME HEALTH AIDES

These staff members are trained and certified to provide a wide range of personal care services. They may include; bathing, grooming, skin care, support with hygiene and sanitary matters, as well as limited meal preparation. This service is available only in conjunction with Skilled Nursing or Therapy services.

THERAPY SERVICES

SOCIAL SERVICES

As a services to patients who have lifestyle issues that are related to their injury or illness, social Workers assist the patient and his/her family or caregiver in resolving social or emotional problem be assessing community resources and counseling related to the personal matters and relationships.

A skilled staff of therapists is available to assist in the patient's rehabilitation.

- SPEECH THERAPY

These professional are instrumental in supporting the recovery of Stroke patients, those who have had orthopedic surgery, and patients with illnesses that have affected their neuro muscular abilities. The focus is on the restoration of mobility and strengthening programs, as well as improvement in the use of extremities and activities of daily living. Speech therapy is provided for patients with who have experiences loss of communication skills, or disabilities related to speaking or swallowing.

How Would I Arrange For Home Health Services?

Anyone is eligible for a free Home Health evaluation to determine their need for services. If appropriate, your physician would need to request Home Health services on your behalf.
